## Performance Ratings App

The Performance Ratings app offers detailed reports on the ratings of non-SES/SP<sup>1</sup> employees and executives, as well as the overall distribution of ratings across an agency. The following have been updated within this app:

### **Non-SES/SP Performance Ratings Report:**

- The All Ratings page has been renamed to All Ratings (List).
- Added the Select a Rating Tier section to the All Ratings (List) page to allow users to:
  - View only Summary Ratings using the Summary button (default view).
  - View only Element Ratings using the Element button.
  - View a combination of Summary Ratings and Element Ratings using the Both button.
- Added the Plan Purpose as a new column in the table on the All Ratings (List) page.
- Adjusted the All Ratings (List) page to include Agency Identifiers by default. Removed the Hide Agency IDs and Show Agency IDs toggles.

### **SES Performance Ratings Report:**

- The All Ratings page has been renamed to All Ratings (List).
- Added the Select a Rating Tier section to the All Ratings (List) page to allow users to:
  - View only Summary Ratings using the Summary button (default view).
  - View only Critical Element Ratings using the Cr. Element button.
  - View a combination of Summary Ratings and Critical Element Ratings using the Both button.
- Adjusted the All Ratings (List) page to include Agency Identifiers by default. Removed the Hide Agency IDs and Show Agency IDs toggles.
